RURAL RECYCLING DROP OFF TRAILERS

The District provides recycling collection trailers at various locations throughout the county.

HOURS: Drop off allowed 24 hours / day, 7 days / week (unless otherwise specified)

ALLOWED MATERIALS:

ONLY the items listed below may be deposited into the collection trailers. We appreciate your *desire* to recycle EVERYTHING. However, we ONLY collect those materials that **can actually be recycled** once collected on these trailers. PLEASE do not contaminate the truly recyclable materials by placing other unacceptable items in the trailers!

Trailers are designed for normal “household quantities” of materials. Anyone with a large volume must deliver that material to a manned drop off center (see list on reverse side).

PLEASE NOTE: WE NO LONGER COLLECT PAPER ON THE TRAILERS DUE TO CONTAMINATION.

TYPE OF MATERIAL	PREPARATION TIPS
No. 1 Plastic Bottles & Jugs (PETE) – Must have a “Neck” (base is wider than the mouth) – NO clamshell containers.	Empty and rinse container (if possible) and replace cap loosely. Crush container as flat as possible.
No. 2 Natural HDPE Bottles & Jugs Must have a “Neck” (base is wider than the mouth) – NO tubs or wide-top containers.	Empty and rinse container (if possible) and replace cap loosely. Crush container as flat as possible.
No. 2 Colored HDPE Bottles & Jugs Must have a “Neck” (base is wider than the mouth) – NO tubs or wide-top containers.	Empty and rinse container (if possible) and replace cap loosely. Crush container as flat as possible.
Aluminum Beverage Cans (magnet will NOT stick)	Empty and rinse container (if possible); crush container.
CARDBOARD MIX - Corrugated Cardboard, Boxboard (Chipboard) & Brown Paper Bags – DOES NOT include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> cardboard with food or other residues on it soda, beer, or other beverage case boxes 	Remove ALL packaging materials from inside boxes such as plastic, styrofoam, etc. Flatten boxes . You may also have to fold over-sized boxes to fit them through the trailer slots.
Glass Bottles and Jars - DOES NOT include flat glass, window or mirror glass, ceramic, cookware, bulbs, etc.	Empty and rinse container (if possible) and replace cap loosely. No need to remove labels. May be in separate bins for Green & Blue, Brown, Clear
Steel Cans (magnet will stick to this) - DOES NOT include other types of metal such as pots, pans, etc.	Rinse container and flatten if possible. No need to remove labels.



NEVER place your material on the ground or on top of collection trailers!

Trailers are switched out on a schedule each week. If one or more of the containers or the trailer is full, please take your material back with you and return another time.

Don't cancel out your positive recycling contributions by

depositing unacceptable materials, or illegally dumping material onto the ground and causing litter and pollution. These behavior increases the program costs and could cause the program to be canceled.

LARGE ITEM RECYCLING

The District accepts certain large items for recycling from Benton County households through our Special Waste Drop Off Program. Fees may apply.

These items include:

- Electronics
- Tires
- Metal Items
- Appliances (whether or not manufactured to contain refrigerant)

BUSINESS RECYCLING

Businesses and other non-household sites may be able to contract with a waste hauler to provide a special on-site collection bin for your recyclable materials for a fee. For information, contact your waste hauler directly or contact the District at (479) 795-0751 for a list of waste haulers that provide service in your area.
